One of the most demanding schools in the U.S. Armed Forces, DLIFLC is also the premier language learning institution in the world. The courses of instruction are intense. Students are in class 5 days a week, 6 hours a day learning one of the 23 languages currently taught here. Our basic level courses vary from six months in length (including French, Spanish, and Portuguese) to 18 months (Arabic, Chinese, Korean, and Japanese, for example). At the end of that time, our graduates get to a higher level of language proficiency than most college language majors attain in four years.

In addition, our students earn 45 semester hours of college credit and can obtain an Associate of Arts degree upon completion of all requirements. Accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, Accrediting Commission for Community, and Junior Colleges and authorized as a federal degree-granting institution by the U.S. Congress, DLIFLC has awarded more than 11,000 AA degrees since 2002. Enjoy Language Day 2015! Talk with our students and faculty as you roam around the campus and through our corridors. They are eager to meet you and share with you their experiences, insights, and their passion for learning languages. This is one secret we want to pass on!
